# Applicant: Cichonowicz, Paul, 1054 Cedar Mountain Road, Castleton- Request for approval for Expansion of a Non-conforming Structure with Conforming Use & Setbacks

J. Thomas stated that the request is for a proch with a deck and handicap access across the deck. The parcel is in the R40 district, and the setbacks are a problem. The lake setback is 45 feet, and 50 feet is required.

G. Chader asked if the deck will be covered. P. Cichonowicz stated that it would be open.

J. Thomas stated that the deck also allows a second egress from the home, and a handicap ramp.

P. Ciconowicz noted that they lost 7 feet of frontage due to lake erosion.
