#### 4. Directors' Report

A. Clapp reported that the After School Grant has been submitted and the award date is May 26, 2021. The summer camp relies on this grant in order to run at an affordable cost to campers. The grant amount was for \$35,000.00 which will enable the campers to enroll for \$50 per week and CIT's to enroll for \$10 per week. There will be additional adult staff hired, also. The Town is being consulted about a requirement of hiring lifeguards. The regularly scheduled "Pop Up" activities will be offered to campers at an additional \$10 per activity.

Tennis has been added to the summer programming for both adults (\$100) and children (\$30). The children will get a Tee shirt and a racket for their own. This program is running with the assistance of the US Tennis Foundation.

M. Hardt reported that baseball/softball is going well with games starting this week. She also complimented the parents for the great turnout and hard work that was done on the April clean up day. She also reported that Dewey Field was mowed today. The mask mandate for players was also lifted by the Governor.

6. Old Business
