10 year SEWER & WASTEWATER PLANNING STUDY- WAYNE ELLIOTT

M. Shea introduced W. Elliott of AE (Aldrich & Elliott) Water Resource Engineers. W. Elliott asked the Board if they had received copies of the report. They had.

The town initiated this study plan because the Sewer Treatment plant is close to being 20 years old. The typical design life of a plant is 20 years. The town has asbestos in the sewer lines and the structural integrity of the pipes is being compromised. The plant is at 60% of its operating capacity now.

There are two priorities that were discussed are:

- #1) Route 30 Sewer line replacement.
- #2) Waste Water Treatment Facility (ultraviolet system)

W. Elliott informed the Board of a few ways to find additional funding for these projects. He also presented a timeline for both projects.
