CALL MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Select Board Chair J. Leamy at 10:00 a.m.

KILCHEVSKY CULVERT

J. Leamy stated the purpose of this emergency meeting is for allocating funds from FEMA for the Little Rutland Road drainage project. R. Combs went to site yesterday with D. Fabricious to go over what is going to be done. They will dig into the existing retaining wall to connect to the existing culvert and run pipe all the way to the lake. They will need 120 feet of pipe, and have lined up renting a 150 and a 40 excavator, which has been organized with G Stone in Middlebury. Both machines will be rented for \$2,540 for two days. The cost of the pipe is \$5,317.20, for a total of \$7,851.20. B. Clark believes with the weather holding out they can get it done in a next couple days. They will have to bring Heath Goyette in off vacation and there may be some overtime involved, depending on how it goes. It was stated the section under the retaining wall may be a struggle, but once they get through that it should go fairly well. R. Combs asked when they will start and when it would be done. B. Clark stated they will start tomorrow morning, he wants to have the pipe in by Wednesday afternoon and it should resolve the issue. They will have to go back in the spring to do the topsoil and seed it. There is \$14,000 in the FEMA funds available. **R. Combs made a motion to approve the use of FEMA funds for the project on Little Rutland Road for up to \$14,000 for the drainage project. J. Mark seconded. All voted in favor. Motion carried 3-0.**

ADJOURN

J. Mark made a motion to adjourn at 10:06 a.m. R. Combs seconded. All voted in favor. Motion carried 3-0.
