

The Rutland Regional Planning Commission (RRPC) and the Town of Castleton, in conjunction with the Vermont Agency of Transportation Project Delivery Bureau - Municipal Assistance, have begun a Scoping Study, Castleton TAP TA 20(2), for pedestrian improvements along Main Street (VT Route 4A) between the Delaware & Hudson Rail Trail trailhead and Sand Hill Road and South Street between Main Street and the Delaware & Hudson Trail.
