## B.) NATURE AND SCOPE OF POSITION:

**Highway crew and equipment operator** for the Town of Castleton. Full time. Hourly wage.

## **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The highway crew and equipment operators are required to perform at a skilled level. The positions are under the direct supervision of the Highway Foreman.

- 1. Responsible or the operation of dump trucks, loaders, graders, tractors, skid steer, chainsaws, woodchippers, mowers, and general maintenance vehicles in hauling materials, snow removal, sand and/or salt spreading, road/roadside and ditching maintenance of Town of Castleton owned, leased or rented roads or properties.
- 2. Perform strenuous manual labor in connection with highway maintenance and some minor construction, brush cutting, culvert installation, retaining walls, tree removal, etc.
- 3. Ability to operate heavy construction machinery including grader, loaders, excavators, and rock crusher.
- 4. Responsible for maintenance of Town of Castleton properties, beaches, ball fields, parks, roadside mowing, and the mowing of cemeteries.
- 5. Provide support to the mechanic, as required, to repair and maintain vehicles and equipment. Responsible for using Town directed forms/logs for before, during, and after operations preventive maintenance checks and services. Responsible for reporting immediately any equipment defects, safety checks, or accidents on Town directed forms/logs.
- 6. Wood cutting related to heating of Town of Castleton Highway Garage and routine maintenance of garage.
- 7. Light preventive maintenance, checks, and services of Town of Castleton owned, rented, or leased vehicles and equipment.
- 8. Perform any and all other related duties required to support efficient and effective Town of Castleton operations, as required or directed.

## REQUIREMENTS OF THE JOB:

- 1. Thorough knowledge of operation of trucks and related automotive or motorized equipment.
- 2. Knowledge of the operation of heavy equipment loader, grader, excavator, backhoe, mower, and crusher.
- 3. Knowledge of traffic laws and regulations involved in equipment operation.
- 4. Ability to understand and follow simple oral communications.
- 5. Ability to maintain effective relationship with public and co-workers.

- 6. Must have good physical strength, dexterity as well as physical stamina to work under adverse weather conditions and on hilly, rocky, or other varied or difficult terrain.
- 7. Must possess a valid Commercial Driver's License in the Employee's State of Residence and a good driving record. Responsible to keep their Commercial Driver's License updated and a copy provided to the Town Manager or his Administrative Assistant upon renewal or upgrades so it can be placed in their personnel file.
- 8. Wear personal protective equipment (PPE) as required by vehicle/equipment manufacturer recommendations, OSHA/VOSHA requirements, Department of Transportation recommendations, or otherwise directed by the Highway Supervisor, Road Commissioner, Town Manager, or Emergency Management Director.

## EDUCATION, TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:

1. Graduation from a standard or vocational high school or successfully completed the GED program, or an equivalent combination of the above or additional training and experience.
