



Sewer Connection

Town Permits:

Homeowner will complete the Sewer Application Permits obtained at the Town Office and return the application back to the Town with applicable fees.

The application fees need to be in separate checks, there should be a total of 5 checks made out to the Town of Castleton.

1. Preliminary Application Fee (Base Fee)	\$35.00 + \$750.00	Total \$785.00
2. Final Allocation Fee	\$35.00	Total \$35.00
3. Wye inspection fee, Connection (Per Wye)	\$35.00 + \$100.00	Total \$135.00

- ❖ The Sewer Commission/ Sewer Supervisor will approve or deny any application
- ❖ The construction and physical hookup to the town sewer line must be physically inspected by the Town Sewer Supervisor.

State Permits:

The homeowner must hire a State certified site engineer to design a system that will satisfy all State and local design criteria. The site engineer must then apply electronically and pay the applicable fee based on design flow. If the plan is approved, the homeowner can then hire someone or self-install the system.
